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Custom Office

User-Defined Fields (UDFs)

- Custom Field that can be added to almost any Sage 100 table
- A UDF can flow-through to forms and reports
- A UDF can flow from one table to another
- Available Control Types
 - Multi-Line
 - Drop-Box
 - List-Box
 - Check-Box

User-Defined Fields (UDFs) cont'd

- Available Data Types
 - String
 - Numeric
 - Date
- UDFs can be a Required Field

User-Defined Tables (UDTs)

- Can be used to validate UDFs
- Can be used as a data source for other UDFs
- Used to maintain information that can be accessed by all companies

Custom Office

Customizer

- Allows you to add UDFs
- Modify screens
 - Hide fields
 - Bold fields
 - Disable fields
- Edit Tab stop sequence
- Create custom Panels by Customization Group

Visual Integrator

- V/I allows you to import or export data in Sage 100
- V/I Jobs
 - Import or Export data from multiple tables
 - Can be scheduled to run at a specified time
 - Can be chained to run one after the other
- Data can be selected by evaluating specified fields

VBscript

- Scripting allows for the addition of features and functionality to your current Sage 100 installation
- It is a non-invasive cost-effective alternative to custom programming
- A VBScript can:
 - Automatically populate a Sage 100 field
 - Perform a calculation
 - Integrate Sage 100 with other applications
 - Scheduled using Microsoft Windows Task Scheduler
