QuickBooks Desktop and QuickBooks Online

QuickBooks was first launched in the 1980s, and, while it has seen some technological upgrades, including the introduction of QuickBooks Online (QBO), significant functional gaps remain. QBO operates on a SaaS architecture, yet it still requires extensive integrations, customizations, and ongoing maintenance. The QuickBooks desktop platform has never been fully re-architected to embrace modern digital capabilities, making it difficult for QuickBooks to meet customers' evolving needs and growth opportunities. This often leads to high maintenance costs that negatively impact financial performance.

Migrating from QuickBooks desktop to QuickBooks Online isn't a seamless process. You'll encounter fewer functions, lose customizations, and face integration challenges due to the inability to test upgrades beforehand. Instead of making this transition, consider exploring other options for migration. You may discover that, while the effort is similar, other accounting and financial management systems provide a lower total cost of ownership (TCO) and significantly enhance efficiency and productivity. These solutions, such as Acumatica, are designed natively in the cloud to meet the needs of growing businesses like yours.

Intuit Enterprise Suite: Stepping Stone or Stumbling Block?

In September 2024, Intuit introduced the Intuit Enterprise Suite (IES), featuring multi-entity management and dimensional reporting to target mid-sized businesses. While IES may offer a smoother transition from QuickBooks Online initially, it is not a true ERP system and can lead to complications down the road. Originally built for lower mid-sized businesses, IES falls short in key areas like multicurrency support, native CRM, and robust industry-specific capabilities, such as comprehensive project and inventory management, warehouse management, and native POS.

Investing in IES now isn't worth your business's time, money, or effort because you'll quickly outgrow it as your company expands.
